Option A

Entering Grades 3-5 Elementary Summer Reading Responses

1. Create a cartoon version of the book: Create a cartoon summarizing the book you read that includes the main characters as well as the conflict and solution. This can be done by hand or through a digital application.
2. Create a poster to advertise your book: A movie poster gives you just enough information to help you know what a book is about. Be sure to include the title, author, and main characters. Use pictures that support the storyline, create a tagline that will make others want to read the book, and include a rating.
3. Create a slideshow: Use a tool such as PowerPoint or Google Slides to create a slideshow summary of your book with pictures, word, audio, and video.
4. Dear Diary: Write a one-week diary as if you were the main character in the book. Through the entries, be sure to help your audience understand the plot, conflict, resolution, and roles of other characters.

You can choose to use any technology or programs with which you are familiar to enhance your project.
